

Talk Boost KS1 Tracker Banding Amends - FAQs

1. What does this mean for groups we have already run?

If you have used the online system to upload scores for groups already run these will have been automatically adjusted and you will be able to see these results on your account.

2. What about children who have changed their banding?

The starting point of some children may have been adjusted to a red banding, the end point for most children remains either amber or green. A few children may start in red and end in red. Our advice remains the same for all children whose scores are either red or amber following the intervention. We advise continued support and that referral for specialist support may be required. This advice remains the same.

3. Will it change the scores for children?

No, the children's individual scores remain the same, the banding has been adjusted to ensure that scores fall into red/amber/green categories to reflect how near children are to where they should be for their age.

4. Will I need to redo the tracker with children I have already used it on?

If you have used the online scoring system, the banding will have automatically been refreshed. The children's scores are unaffected by this adjustment.

5. How do I get hold of an update version of the tracker?
